



AIRLESS SPRAY SPECIFICATIONS

- Use an airless sprayer that can pump approximately .75 gallons per minute or greater
- 1/4" hose will work, however, a 3/8" hose will reduce strain on sprayer
- Remove all filters and lower the pressure
- .21 - .25 tip sizes work well
- Keep a clean bucket of water available, as an occasional flush of your pump may be necessary on hot days to alleviate clogs and the pumps inability to build up pressure
- Apply Smart Strip, from bottom up, approximately 1/8" thick (Spread rate should be 40 – 50 sq. ft./gallon)
- Allow stripper to dwell on surface for 6 - 24 hours (Conduct a test patch to establish required dwell time)
- When applying stripper on hot days and/or in direct sunlight it may begin to dry up before removal. Reapply a second coat to re-wet original coat about 45 minutes prior to removal
- Remove stripper and finish by power washing surface from top to bottom. Rinse surface thoroughly with water after removal of stripper and finish
- Do not leave Smart Strip in sprayer or spray line overnight as the 5% Formic Acid will begin to corrode your pump quickly. Flush sprayer and hose thoroughly each day and upon completion with warm water.
